

Speaker 1: Adrian Taylor, Director, Policy and Strategy Advice, European School of Governance, Germany

Adrian Taylor is Director, Policy and Strategy Advice, for the European School of Governance (gGmbH) in Berlin. In his work Adrian supports public and private sector clients by facilitating their strategic thinking processes, notably employing scenarios and Open Source Intelligence. He has a particular interest in governance issues, as well as the European Union, and has acquired a deeper knowledge of EU foreign, security, environment and development policy, as well as the European energy, petrochemicals and transport sectors.

Adrian previously held a short Service Limited Commission in the British Army (1985), has been a lobbyist on EU matters (1989-1992), was a scenario planner in a joint venture with Global Business Network (1992-1995), was Desk Officer for India at the European Commission (1995-1999) and spent a year as a visiting scholar at Georgia Tech (2000). He was also President of the European Open Source Intelligence Forum (2006 to 2008).

His education includes 1st Class Honours Degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics Trinity College Oxford, and a Licence Spéciale (Masters) in European Studies with "Grande Distinction" from the Université Libre de Bruxelles. Adrian is also author of a number of published essays, and regularly contributes editorial pieces to on-line journals.

Adrian was born and raised in London, England, and has subsequently spent 20 years living elsewhere, notably Gibraltar, Brussels, Atlanta, Zurich, New York, and Munich. He and his wife and two children currently reside in Hamburg.
