T. Irene Sanders is the founder and executive director of the Washington Centre for Complexity and Public Policy. As the author of *Strategic Thinking and the New Science: Planning in the Midst of Chaos, Complexity and Change* (The Free Press, 1998), she pioneered the application of complexity science to strategic thinking – the most essential skill in today’s fast-paced global environment. She developed the FutureScape® visual thinking tool, which rapidly enhances insight and foresight in any type of planning exercise.

Her work has been featured in a wide range of publications including *Art Education, Continental, Foresight, Investor’s Business Daily, The Rocky Mountain News, Urban Land* and *The Washington Post*. She has developed educational programs in complexity for a diverse group of organizations including the University of Colorado at Boulder, CTU Institute for Advanced Studies at Colorado Springs, the CIA, Ingersoll Rand Company, University of Lecce (Italy), and the Smithsonian Institution.

She has been a conference speaker for U.S. military and intelligence organizations including CIA, DIA, DLA (*Combatant Command Day*), National Defense University (*Commandant’s Lecture*), USAWC and the U.S. Special Operations Command, Pacific (SOCPAC) conference on *Combating Terrorism in Southeast Asia*. She served as legislative assistant to U.S. Senator Sam Nunn and has facilitated strategic thinking and planning sessions for committees and individual members of the U.S. Congress.
