

Speaker 2: Timothy Mack, President, World Future Society, United States

Since 1985, **Tim Mack** has edited *Futures Research Quarterly*. In June of 2004, he assumed the Presidency of the World Future Society, which is the largest membership organization in the futures field.

Mr. Mack has been a member of the New York and District of Columbia bars since the 1970s and has served as General Counsel for a number of for profit and non-profit organizations. After holding research positions at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and at the US National Academy of Sciences, Tim Mack joined the Budget Policy Task Force at the US General Accounting Office, which serves as the analytical arm of the US Congress. He subsequently spent five years as a Vice President at WPP Ltd (one of the largest management consulting and market communications company in the world) and served on the Board of the MIT Enterprise Forum, a non-profit group assisting innovative companies.

Tim Mack worked with the US General Services Agency and the US Dept of Defense in developing strategic planning and change management strategies and assisted the Institute for Global Chinese Affairs (ranked Number One globally by the Foreign Experts Bureau in Beijing).
