

**Speaker 3: Clement Bezold**

**Clement Bezold** is a futurist, facilitator and co-founder of the Institute for Alternative Futures with Alvin Toffler and Jim Dator. IAF was designed to encourage "Anticipatory Democracy." He has worked with governments, communities and corporations to better understand the threats and opportunities of the future and create their preferred future.

He has worked on enhancing foresight in all branches and levels of government from communities and cities, through states and national governments and their agencies, to the European Union, APEC, and UN organizations, particularly the World Health Organization.

Bezold applied futures approaches to public and private sector organizations on six continents working with organizations such as International Refugee Committee, and The Rockefeller Foundation as well as AT&T, BASF, Bayer, GlaxoSmithKline, Ford, Mead, Scott, and Siemens.

Bezold is the author, co-author or editor of numerous reports and books dealing with the future and foresight on a number of topics including Anticipatory Democracy, The Future of Work and Health, and Judging the Future. He is Consulting Editor of Journal of Futures Studies, and is on the editorial/advisory boards of Technology Forecasting and Social Change, foresight, and World Future Review.
