

Speaker 2: Gerard P. Hodgkinson

Director, Centre for Organisational Strategy, Learning and Change, Leeds University Business School, United Kingdom

Gerard P. Hodgkinson is Professor of Organizational Behaviour and Strategic Management and Director of the Centre for Organizational Strategy, Learning and Change at LUBS. His work, which centres on the analysis of cognition (thinking, reasoning and decision making) in organizations and applied psychological measurement, has appeared in a number of the world's leading academic journals (e.g. the Annual Review of Psychology, Organizational Research Methods, Risk Analysis, Personnel Psychology, and Strategic Management Journal) and edited volumes. He is an elected Fellow of both the British Psychological Society and the British Academy of Management and in 2008 was elected an Academician of the Academy of Social Sciences (AcSS). He was the Editor-in-Chief of the British Journal of Management (1999 – 2006) and currently co-edits (with J. Kevin Ford) the International Review of Industrial and Organizational Psychology and serves on several Editorial Boards including the Academy of Management Review, Journal of Management, Journal of Organizational Behavior, and Organization Science. With William H. Starbuck he recently co-edited The Oxford Handbook of Organizational Decision Making. Registered with the Health Professions Council as an Occupational Psychologist, over the past twenty five years he has carried out numerous consultancy assignments with public and private sector organizations.
