Ruan Zongze, born in 1965, is Vice-President, and Senior Fellow at CIIS, as well as Editor-in-Chief of the CIIS journal, *China International Studies*. He is also serving as UNDP Human Development Report Advisory Panel member and a Member of ASEAN Regional Forum (ARF) Experts & Eminent Persons.

Prior to that, he was Minister Counsellor for Policy at the Embassy of the PRC in the U.S. from 2007 to 2011. He was appointed as Vice-President at CIIS from 2002 to 2007. Mr. Ruan served as Second and First Secretary at the Chinese Embassy in the UK from 1996 to 2000. From 1992 to 1993, he was visiting fellow at School of Oriental and African Studies, University of London, UK.

His areas of research include Chinese foreign policy, American foreign policy, and Asia-Pacific security and development. He appears frequently on China Central Television and other major media. He received his Ph.D. from China Foreign Affairs University and is author of the following two books, *A Diplomat's Inside View of America* (Jiang Su People's Publishing LTD, Nanjing, 2012.11) and *The Rise of China and the Transition of East Asia Order: Shaping and Expanding the Shared Interests* (Peking University Press, Beijing, 2007).
